Sunday, April 29, 11:00 am & 4:00 pm



LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends,

The 11:00 service this Sunday will be a milestone moment for 13 of our young people. For the past year, these young people have been meeting, sharing, learning, and praying together and today they will stand before us and we will confirm the faith that was first spoken to them at their baptism. Today is the day that they say to us, “We are ready to take this next step of faith!”

For us here at Royal Oak First, Confirmation is not just about memorizing the dates and facts about Jesus, the history of Christianity, or the particulars of the United Methodist Church. Confirmation does not mean passing a test by having the right answers to a set of theological or doctrinal questions. Your selfless giving of your time and talent will leave an indelible mark on these students forever. You have lived your faith in front of them—they have seen Christ in you. Thank you for your service.
