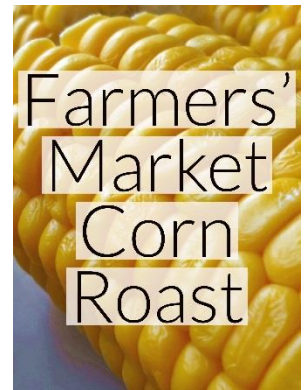
Corn Roast at the Royal Oak Farmers' Market
