NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends,

Just when we start adjust to the changes swirling around us, something new comes into play. These are unprecedented times. Last week, a small group of us brought you the service from an empty sanctuary. On Monday we discussed ways to improve the live feed that comes to all of you. Then, on Tuesday, Pastor James and I went into isolation because we had direct contact with a confirmed case of the virus. (We are both fine; neither of us has any symptoms.) Working remotely, we continue to move forward to make Christ's love real in new ways. Let me share with you a few things that are happening. Right now.

- The Calling Circle of Care is in motion. I hope many of you have received a call. We expand of calling list every day. My hope is that every one of us will call and be called. We just want you to remember that you (yes, you,) are important to God and you are important to your church family. We also want to ask what we can do for you? Do you need help getting groceries? And, what can we be praying for, for you?
 - Beyond the church-wide calling circle, there are other calling circles going on as well. Several of the small groups are launching call chains, to give everyone one more point of contact, one more connection.
- Our Lenten Grow Groups are still going, just in new ways. We are connecting and continuing
 to study the book UnAfraid through emails and online live face-to-face chats. Two weeks remain
 in our current schedule, but we will extend classes during the quarantine. If you are not in a

- For our children: Children's Time with Pastor Myra is live on Facebook every weekday at 4pm (or you can view it any time after that.) Just go to the Royal Oak First Facebook page. As most of you know, I taught Sunday School for many years and I'm having a blast getting back into that role. I have seen plenty of adults watching too... I love that.
- **Children's Sunday School** We have "grab and go" Sunday School lessons. Starting Saturday at 10am you can come by and pick up a lesson packet from the bin just outside the Tower entrance.
- Sunday Services at 9 and 11. Yes, we will be broadcasting our live stream at 9 and at 11. I'll be leading worship, coming remote from my house and Pastor James will be preaching from his remote location. We will also have special music and some places for you to sing along from wherever you are.

I still can't believe we set the sermons series, UnAfraid, back in December. (And we thought we were just talking about politics and the election year...)

I said it last week in my sermon and I will say it again. Our God is on the move in new and amazing ways in the midst of all that is happening around us. These are extraordinary times, but don't forget, we worship an extraordinary God.
