

Hello Friends,

I am amazed at how much time has passed since we last met in person. I must admit I'm a bit nervous about speaking in person. It is hard to believe that I am speaking to you for the 3rd time, and it is actually the 1st time I'll see you live and in living color in the Sanctuary. So much has happened over the last 18 months. Thank you for the opportunity to update you on our world at the Prud'homme household.

First though, Pastor Jeff and his bride Bridget are up north at band camp supporting their upand-coming musical genius in the family, blessings on a successful trip. I know that you miss him and are grateful for the chance to visit with your son.

For those who don't know me (and those that do as well), I am 70% through in seminary. My ministry as a Deacon - Environmental and Social Justice - has received the blessing from the District Committee on Ordained Ministry (DCOM) and moved me along to the Board of Ordained Ministry (BOOM) at the Conference level.
