LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends,

I wanted to continue to update you on our COVID-19 cases in the last two weeks. We had seven persons connected with our choir test positive for COVID. I am so glad to report that all of them are recovering well and none required any hospitalization. In addition, I am thankful that there was no spread of the virus beyond the choir and the rehearsal prior to the October 31 worship. To ensure both the protection of myself and our community, I have tested twice in the last week and both tests were negative.

The events of this past week have been a reminder that we are still in the midst of this global pandemic. It has caused us to revisit our procedures and protocols to ensure we are balancing hospitality and safety. We have decided to pause all singing ensembles. We will call upon song leaders, soloists and small groups of two or three to provide music leadership for worship. A big thank you Tim Schoenherr, Erica Plesco, Tim Coleman and Kyle Webber for their creative and resilient leadership during these interesting times.

Two of the creative resilient responses to this moment will happen during Advent. Pastors Bridget and Jennifer will be hosting our annual women's Advent evening again via Zoom. This will give the women of the church a chance to connect together for worship and friendship at the start of this holy season. "Laughing All the Way: A Night of Christmas Cheer for Women" will be held on Monday, December 13 at 7:30pm via Zoom. More details on this event will follow soon.

The second will be our annual Feast of Carols Christmas Concert. This has been an annual favorite, combining all the musical ensembles in the church for a night of music to support our Music Guild and their efforts to support our summer Choir Camp. This year our Feast of Carols will be a Community-Wide Carol Sing outside on the front lawn and surrounding sidewalks. This will take place on Sunday, December 12 from 3:00-3:45pm. Together we will share the songs of the season with the community. There will be song sheets, hot chocolate, Christmas treats and some chairs for you to sit on. Please plan to come and share your love with the community.

This is what makes me so proud to be a part of Royal Oak First. In the midst of these difficult and often confusing times, we continue to find ways to gather and share the love of Christ with each other and the world. Thank you for doing all you can to keep yourself and our community safe. And thank you for joining us in all these creative ways of being the Church.
