LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

"Bethlehem was God with us, Calvary (the cross) was God for us, and Pentecost is God in us."

Dear Friends,

I love this quote. It captures the essence of this Sunday's celebration so well. Pentecost Sunday - the day we remember that the Holy Spirit, the life that animated Jesus, also lives in you and in me. Let that sink in for a minute.

The same spirit that led Jesus to feed the hungry, comfort the sick, confront evil, and even rise from the dead, that same spirit is in you and is in me. That is what Pentecost Sunday is all about.

The term Pentecost comes from the Greek Word meaning "fiftieth". It refers to the Jewish festival of Shavuot celebrated on the fiftieth day after Passover. In the Christian tradition, Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after Easter.
