LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends,

If there is one message I want to get across to all of you right now it is this:

You are needed! The church needs you. Your pastor needs you. And most importantly, God needs you.

One of the unintended consequences of the past two years of social distancing and online worship has been we, the church staff, have had to figure out how to do church - especially worship - without you.

We had to figure out how to make music, do Sunday School, collect offerings, greet people, serve coffee, read the scriptures and all the other things that make church happen with fewer people. And frankly - it stunk!

It is better - in every single way - when you are involved. Not just in the "more hands make for light work" sort of way, but it is better when you are involved because of what you bring to the experience. You bring you! You bring your joy, your experience, your ideas, your outlook to the community. And we are missing you!

And the truth is, God created us to serve and therefore God's church is a place where everybody gets a chance to serve.

So starting this month, myself and our team will be dedicated to helping each of you get a place to serve, and we are starting with the Sunday worship and fellowship experience.

So beginning this week I am asking each of you to do one of the following:

- If you are attending in-person worship regularly right now, please find a regular place to serve on at least a monthly basis. After service each week, there will be someone there to help you find and get scheduled for a place to serve.
- 2. If you are primarily worshiping online (I know. Church in your pajamas with your coffee is hard to beat!) I am asking you to consider coming to in-person worship at least once a month to serve. You can contact Bridget Nelson (248.541.4100 or bnelson@rofum.org) and she will help get you scheduled for a regular service opportunity.
- 3. If you are not ready or not able to return to in-person worship, that is ok! We still need you and you can serve God and our church from home. Please contact Bridget Nelson (248.541.4100 or bnelson@rofum.org) and she will help you find a way to serve.

I can't say it more plainly. You are needed! The church needs you. I need you. God needs you.

It's time to make the church a place where everybody can serve.
