
EASTER EGG FILLERS COLLECTION

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends,

This quote comes from Richard Rohr (one of my favorite writers) from his book "Falling Upward":

"Most of us were taught that God would love us if and when we change. In fact, God loves you so that you can change. What empowers change, what makes you desirous of change is the experience of love. It is that inherent experience of love that becomes the engine of change."

This is the "big switch" that Jesus encourages everyone he encounters to experience. Jesus invites us to switch our understanding of faith from one where we need to change in order to be loved, to a faith where because you are loved you are free to make changes.

This is at the core of Jesus' encounter this week with a woman at a Samaritan well. It is a powerful story of crossing boundaries and discovering the source of living water and at its core, is an invitation to make this "big switch."

And if you have yet to experience "The Chosen," I cannot recommend it enough. It is the best re-telling of Jesus' story I have ever experienced - it is almost as good as the book!
