YOUTH BAKE SALE - MARCH 19



LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends,

I want to share with you a story about how your love makes a difference. Over the Valentine's Day weekend, we delivered over 70 packages of cookies to members of our community. This is our chance to show up and say we are thinking of you and wanted to simply share some of God's love and joy with you. I love to hear the stories of your adventures - I think it must have been how Jesus felt waiting for the disciples to return from their missions.

One story this year has really stuck with me. Tim Ryckman and his son Noah delivered cookies to Lee Hoffmann who lives at the Woodward Hills nursing facility. Tim came back and told me how wonderful it was to see Lee.

During the next few weeks I had the chance to visit Lee myself. She too thanked me for sending our "missionaries" as she called them. She told me what kindness they showed and in particular what a fantastic young person Noah was becoming (he had visited her before). Then with tears in her eyes she told me that the best part of getting the cookies was that it allowed her to share the love of God with her neighbors. All I could picture was Lee in her wheelchair going up and down the hallway offering a sample of the sweet treats that her church had shared with her.

Sometimes I wonder what God's love looks like - and then I learn of a moment like this and it becomes clear.

Mother Teresa once said, "We can't all do great things. But we can do small things with great love!"
