EARTH DAY CLEAN-UP WITH MICAH 6

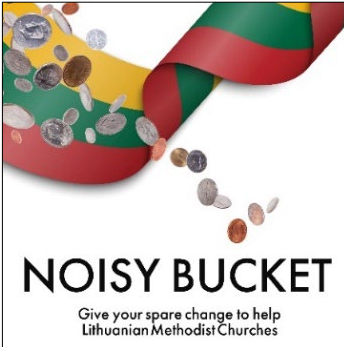

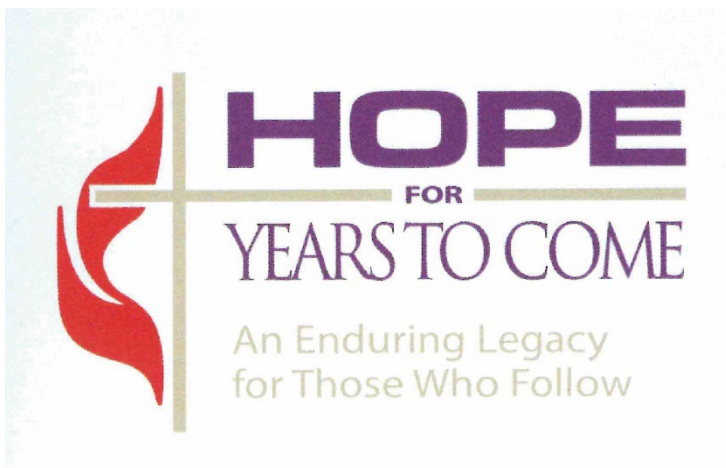
VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL
