

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends,

I wanted to share something really cool that happened which you might have missed. Last Saturday, Pastor Bridget and I had the pleasure of spending the evening with six incredible 8th and 9th graders from our congregation as we embarked on their Confirmation Journey. It was an absolute joy!

We spent time talking and sharing our lives, stories, and interests, reminding each other that God loves us in the unique details of our lives. We discussed our hobbies, dream travel destinations, and even the superpowers we would choose (teleportation seemed to be a popular choice). Through these conversations, we discovered the unique ways God has made us and learned to appreciate the uniqueness of others.

We also played the fun game *Heads Up*, with a promised trip to the famous "Pastor Jeff's Prize Table" for the winners (and those who finished second). In playing, we remembered that God has given us the capacity for fun and joy. It is through shared delight that bonds of community are formed.

Towards the end of the evening, we discussed what it means to be part of a United Methodist Church. We each created a note card to keep in our Bibles, stating why we are United Methodist. Some of the reasons included were: that our experiences matter, our questions are welcomed, our faith is personal and social, our call is to a global movement, and our lives are saved by grace upon grace. We closed the evening with a prayer and even started a group text so we could continue to encourage each other throughout the week.

Little did I know at the time, but I really needed to be at Confirmation that night. It had been a tough week for our world. The ongoing war in Israel and Palestine weighs heavily on my heart. The dysfunction in Congress leaves me disillusioned, and the upcoming election cycle seems daunting. So, spending an evening with bright, funny, engaged, and spiritually curious young people left my heart strangely warmed (as the good old Methodist saying goes!).

Middle school can be tough, which is why I am grateful to be part of a movement that creates space to remind these students that they are truly loved by God and that Jesus wants to help them change the world!

During this season, we are reminding you of all the things God does through your gifts and offerings. I wanted to share this particular story with you. Your generosity helps to make this happen.
