LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends,

With the Thanksgiving holiday approaching, we often set aside time this month to capture our gratuities. Staying rooted in gratitude connects us to God, the source of all goodness, in ways few other disciplines can.

I have always found these words from Paul to the Philippians meaningful - "Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." Paul reminds us to be thankful **IN** all circumstances, not be thankful **FOR** all circumstances. That is a helpful distinction. It reminds me that in even in the worst of circumstances, I can still be rooted in gratitude. No matter what is going on in my life, I have things to be thankful for.

Gratitude doesn't have to be an overwhelming spiritual practice. There are no measures on what is too small to be grateful for. What are you grateful for at this moment? The fact that you woke up this morning? Your morning cup of coffee? The walk you're going to take outside this afternoon? Your pet? Your community?

By recognizing and giving thanks for even the smallest and seemingly insignificant of things, we are able to work our way up to the bigger things. I have been using my gratitude calendar this month to keep this important discipline at the center of life. If you need one you can pick one up at the Connections Table.

Pledge Campaign Update

I want to thank you for the pledges we have received. These pledges are a critical tool that we use for planning our budgets and being good stewards of the resources you invest in Christ's work.

To date, we have received: 122 pledges totaling \$392,366; 43 new pledges totaling \$78,198; increased pledges totaling \$21,160.

Our operating budget for 2024 is proposed at \$975,000. The pledge target is 83% of that number which is \$809,255. We are at 48% of the target. If you are willing and able to make a pledge for 2024, please mail it in or drop it off at the office.
