


WORLD MEDICAL RELIEF-SERVICE DAY

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends,

In Fellowship Hall, on the lower level, hangs the pictures of all the pastors who have had the honor to serve this congregation. (Thankful to Owen and Paul Perkins for the display that tells this story.)

There have been at least 59 senior pastors in the nearly 200 years that Royal Oak First has existed. This week, we pause to give thanks for the life of Reverend Marshall Dunlap who entered into his eternal rest this past week. Marshall and his wife, Reverend Susan Dunlap, faithfully served this congregation from 1999-2009. I am thankful for his ministry, collegial spirit and friendship.

Pastor Bridget and I are particularly thankful for the model Marshall and Susan demonstrated as a clergy couple. They showed this congregation that spouses could work together in mutuality and respect and made it possible for couples like Bridget and myself to be welcomed as a team into ministry. The stories of Marshall and Susan's ministry here are significant. I hear lots of stories of Marshall's wonderful bass singing voice, his commitment to youth and wonderful dry sense of humor. Marshall and Susan made a commitment to a fuller inclusion of all God's people at a time when that was riskier and not always welcome. We have been able to "draw the circle wider" because of the work they did together. And on a personal note, when I went on my leave, Pastor Marshall was one of my colleagues who reached out to make sure I was ok. He was kind, curious and without judgment. It was a call that was necessary and needed at a time of personal struggle. I am proud to have been his colleague in ministry.

For those of you who were blessed by Pastor Marshall's ministry, I know this loss is personal. May God comfort you in your mourning. And for those of us who have connected to this movement since, just know that we are in large part who we are today because of the faithful witness of this humble, kind and caring man.
