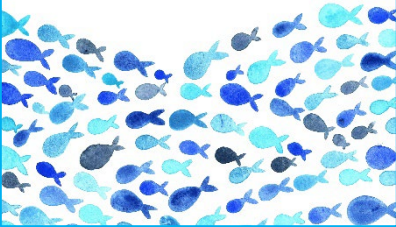

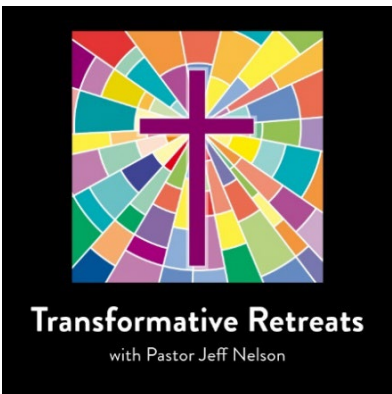
GET READY FOR “EGG MY HOUSE”!

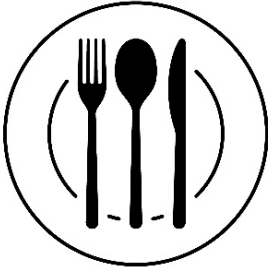

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Beloved Community,

As I take a moment to reflect on our journey together, my heart is full of gratitude for each and every one of you. It's truly inspiring to see how your commitment and generosity breathe life into Christ's love within our community. Thank you for being the hands and feet of that love; it means more than words can express.

Together, we make Christ's love real in four beautiful ways:

1. Extending Inclusive Love to All – Here, every person, no matter their background, is embraced with open arms.
2. Commitment to Children, Youth, and Families – We are nurturing our future, wrapping our young ones in love and guidance.
3. Caring for the Hungry, Unhoused, and Economically Vulnerable – Together, we make a tangible difference in the lives of those in need, reaching out with compassion.
4. Creating Moments to Celebrate God's Presence – Whether it's a baptism, wedding, or a final farewell, we honor life's sacred moments together.

Speaking of sacred moments, I can't help but smile when I think back on the nine baptisms we celebrated this past season! Each one was a unique and precious event, welcoming our youngest members into the embrace of our faith family. Our wonderful Worship & Music Director, Michael Rosas, often shares the joy of our baptisms, noting that in his previous church, they celebrated just one over seven years. To see us come together to honor nine in just one quarter shows the incredible love and support your generosity extends to young families.

One baptism that particularly touched my heart was the day we welcomed four young boys into our faith family. It was a beautiful sight, especially knowing their mothers had all grown up together in this very church! This moment was a touching reminder of God's presence throughout our lives, showing us how faith connects us across generations.

Your generosity makes all of this possible. As we look at our finances for February, I want to share some encouraging news. Our annual budget stands at \$905,033. For February, we projected an income of \$53,356, and thanks to your kindness, we received \$49,221. In January, we brought in \$80,205, leading to a year-to-date total of \$129,426. This is ahead of our projection of \$114,424. Your faithfulness in giving is truly remarkable!

In the coming weeks, keep an eye out for a special invitation for our Easter offering. This is an opportunity to give a little extra, alongside your regular contributions, supporting our ongoing mission of sharing Christ's love in our community. Remember, every gift, no matter how small, plays a role in making that love real.
