

"LIVE IT OUT" VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL




THANK YOU CHRISTINE!


FACEBOOK LIVE DEVOTION EVERY WEDNESDAY AT NOON

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Beloved Community,

As I sit down to write this letter, I can't help but think back to those early days of the pandemic. Do you remember the weight of it all? Each day felt like a new wave of overwhelming news, and it seemed like the world was blanketed in hardship. I'll admit, it was a tough time for me, and I know I wasn't alone in feeling that way.
