LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Beloved Community,

Moments matter.

As I grow older, I realize our lives are marked not just by time but by moments. Moments offer God a chance to break through, whispering truths that resonate in our hearts and connect us. This week, as we gather for worship, we'll encounter three special moments inviting us to pause and reflect on the divine presence in our lives.

Nicole Wilson's Internship:

This week, we begin a new journey with our friend Nicole Wilson. Nicole and her family have been part of our community for some time. We have been blessed by her leadership and deep love for God and people. Currently enrolled at Garrett Evangelical pursuing a Masters of Divinity, Nicole is on the path to ordained ministry in the United Methodist Church. For the next academic year, she will serve more formally with us. Today, we affirm what we already know—God's favor is upon her, and her gifts bless the church and the world. We are glad to provide a space for her to learn and serve. This is a moment for Nicole, her family, and for us to encounter God in new and meaningful ways.

Lynn's Baptism:

This Sunday, we will baptize Lynn Herbert, the granddaughter of Rick and Amy Lieblein. We will stand with their daughter Lisa and her husband Marshall, surrounding them with love and hope. Baptisms are sacred moments—a rite of passage for families, where older generations pause to give thanks for new life and the promise it represents. For congregations, it is a holy moment when we pledge to accompany this family as the hands and heart of Jesus.
