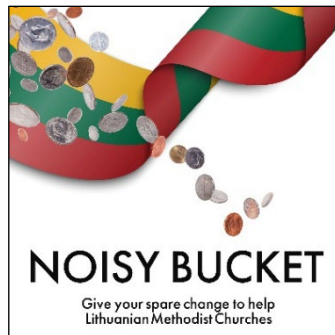


SERVICE FOR OTHERS-FEBRUARY 15

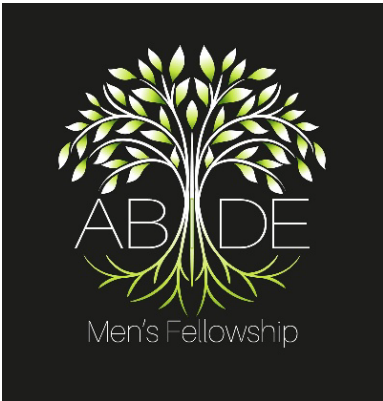


SNACKS (SWEET OR SAVORY) NEEDED FOR THE COFFEE BAR

So, let me say how grateful I am for all of you. I am grateful for the way this community shows up. I am grateful for those of you who come week after week and talk over coffee and snacks and let me get to know you and ask questions and get to know me. I am grateful for the families who come every week to Holy COW and create and inhabit spaces for kids to form foundational friendships.
