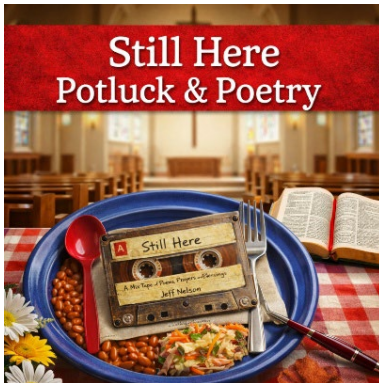

# LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Beloved Community,

This Sunday, five of our eighth graders will be confirmed.

Over the past year, they've been gathering one Saturday a month, laughing, asking honest questions, and trying to make sense of faith and life. And this community has been right there with them, showing up, making room, and walking alongside them.

We haven't asked them to have it all figured out. We've simply tried to help them trust one important truth: that grace comes first.

So when they make mistakes they'll know what to do. They'll know where to come. They won't be afraid to come back.

You may notice the sign this week has a little more tape on it. Nothing dramatic—just reinforced. That feels about right. When life feels uncertain, we don't start over—we press the promise down again and remind each other it still holds.

Confirmation is one of those moments. Not just for them, but for all of us.

So whether you're in the room at 11:00 a.m. service or not, this is your moment too. A moment to remember that you are held, that grace comes first, and that you belong.
